

NOTICE OF A RATE HEARING

Toronto Hydro-Electric System Limited has applied for approval of its proposed Non-Wires Solutions Incentive Mechanism

Toronto Hydro-Electric System Limited (Toronto Hydro) has applied to the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) for approval of a proposed Non-Wires Solutions (NWS) Incentive Mechanism effective May 1, 2026 to December 31, 2029. Specifically, Toronto Hydro requests:

- Approval to apply a 25% Margin-on-Payments (MoP) incentive rate on payments made to its NWS Program participants as proposed.
- Approval for a deferral account to record the MoP incentive amounts for future disposition.
- Other items or amounts that may be requested by the Applicant in the course of the proceeding, and such other relief or entitlements as the OEB may grant.

YOU SHOULD KNOW

In November 2024, the Ontario Energy Board approved Toronto Hydro-Electric System's five-year custom incentive rate application for rates beginning January 1, 2025 (EB-2023-0195). That application included a Local Demand Response (LDR) program to address pressing system needs. The NWS Incentive Mechanism that is the subject of the current application is related to the LDR program funded through Toronto Hydro's approved distribution rates.

Other customers, including businesses, will also be affected. It's important to review the application carefully to determine whether you may be affected by the proposed changes.

There are three types of OEB hearings: oral, electronic and written. The applicant has applied for, and the OEB plans to proceed with, a written hearing. If you think a different hearing type is needed, you can write to us to explain why.

During this hearing, we will hear questions and arguments from participants about this case. We will also hear questions and arguments from participants that have registered as Intervenors. After the hearing, we will decide whether to approve the application.

If you write a letter of comment, your name and the content of your letter will be put on the public record and the OEB website. If you are a business or if you apply to become an intervenor, all the information you file will be on the OEB website.
